As a Freelancer Art Facilitator, I have been working with adults with learning disabilities for Frontline Partnership Ltd since 2014 at the CAFÉ ART, and it's been a joy and an honour to be able to work with you guys.

I have also worked as an Inclusion Support Worker at THE GATES from 2018 until 2023, which is a charity organisation under the umbrella of Frontline Partnership Ltd, providing a beautiful setting for indoors and outdoors horticultural and art activities for adults with learning disabilities.

Since 2014 the CAFÉ ART group has evolved tremendously regarding clients' self-confidence and art skills. In 2021 we had our first Art Exhibition at Brentwood Library and because of its success, we have received more funds to carry on with the project. We have had three art exhibitions already, and we look forward to this year's one.

I'm based at the BRENTWOOD ARTS THERAPY CENTRE in Pilgrims Hatch, Brentwood, which I opened in March 2023. It is an inclusive, safe and inspirational space, offering professional mental health support through Art Therapy. Once a month I run a guided art lesson, which is suitable to anyone, including adults with learning disabilities, as well as other art projects throughout the year.

Apart from being an Artist and Art Psychotherapist, I try to keep fit and healthy with daily exercises and homemade cooking. I have one chicken named Nina in my garden, and I always look forward to having quality time with my lovely husband, friends and family.



Long House Plants is a small retail nursery run by Tim Carter. All the plants are grown here and we have a range of interesting and unusual trees, shrubs, perennials, grasses and alpines, selected to be successful in the local soils. Plant sales are for collection from the nursery only, we do not offer a delivery or mail order service.

There is off road car parking and a loo.

The nursery is all on one level and the loo is suitable for the disabled.

We accept payment by cash, credit and debit cards.

If you are visiting us to buy a specific plant, please contact us first to make sure that it is available.

Please note that only assistance dogs are welcome in the nursery or garden.

You may have noticed our opening hours;

Open from the beginning of March to the end of September

Fridays & Saturdays 10am-5pm, Sundays 10am-4pm

Bank Holidays 10am-5pm

This is to give us enough time to grow all the plants - we will also open by appointment.

We are happy to give advice on the care of plants and advice such as how to design a border or what plants to use in a tricky area. Bring in photos or a digital camera, a note of where the sun rises and sets and what the soil is like. The nursery does get busy, so if you want to spend more time with Tim, make an appointment either by telephone 01708 371719 or leave a message on the contact us section and he will see you before the nursery opens or closes so you can have his undivided attention.
